honor: (n) great respect for someone, or the feeling of pride and pleasure resulting when respect is shown to you. (افتخار، احترام)

Example: It is an honor to met you.

privileged: (adj) having or showing a special advantage. (ممتاز، خاص)

Example: As an old friend of the president, he enjoys privileged status.

Tertiary education: (n) education for people above school age, including college, university, and vocational courses. (تحصیلات عالی)

Example: The policy improves access to tertiary education.

prominent: (adj) very well known and important. (برجسته، والا)

Example: The government should be playing a more prominent role in promoting human rights.

vigorous: (adj) very forceful or energetic. (شدید)

Example: He takes plenty of vigorous exercise.

unanimous: (adj) If a group of people are unanimous, they all agree about one particular matter or vote the same way, and if a decision or judgment is unanimous, it is formed or supported by everyone in a group.

Example: After a lengthy discussion we reached a unanimous decision on the proposal. (متفق القول، هم رای)

legacy: (n) something that is a part of your history or which stays from an earlier time. (میراث)

Example: The Greeks have a rich legacy of literature.
