Disagree

effects of having a strict teacher. When a teacher pays painstaking attention to
the assignments, takes many exams, asks students some questions to get them
involved in the class discussion, and correct their mistakes meticulously, their
aim is to help students improve rather than bothering them. Students, however,
due to lack of forethought, are not pleased with these kinds of activities, and
have no idea that learning all ins and outs of a course can, in the long run,
engenders dramatic changes in their lives.

26. Some people think the media including newspapers, televisions, radio and internet sources are less concerned with the accuracy of news. They think the information from the media is becoming incorrect. Do you agree with this opinion or not and explain why? Include examples and specific reasons.

Agree

- Despite the fact that not all reporters are dishonest, it is my firm conviction that the news must be scrutinized meticulously and it is not reputable enough.
- Most reporters and their organizations are more concerned about the profit they can obtain than are they about actual facts. Magazines, newspapers, radio and television need money in order to stay in business. Therefore, they sometimes forget about the importance of ethical standards, degree of accuracy, impartiality and completeness of news for economic interests. Moreover, since the reporters need to catch the eye of people, they sometimes fabricate engaging stories, or add some unreal details to increase the number of viewers, readers and audiences, and accordingly, enlarge the benefit they make.
- Governments control media and influence it the way they desire. For example, in the Islamic Republic of Iran, the rate of inflation has been stated to be less than thirty percent; nevertheless, according to economists, it is upper than two hundred percent.

• Sometimes the reporters misrepresent the news in order not to frighten people. For example in case of a terrorist attack, the media do not accentuate the attack to ensure people that they are safe.

Realistic goals

Buy cheap foods and cook home.

Clean air, water and land are three essential components for humans' existence, with which human beings are directly in touch. The water people drink goes directly to their stomach, the air they breathe closely circulates in their lungs, and the food they eat is derived from the land so presence of any pollutants literally means contamination of the body and the diseases ensuing. For example, in my city, due to presence of factories which do not use proper air filters, the number of people suffering from death-leading lung diseases is significantly higher than clean cities.

Reading the book first

However, in newspapers and magazines, the authors tell the stories from their personal angles and perspectives, which is considered as second-hand experience and cannot be beneficial as much.

Governments should focus their budgets more on environmental protection than on economic development.

- Needless to say, it is a moral duty to preserve the planet earth and its resources for posterity. Human activities have negatively affected the planet earth. Air pollution, soil corrosion, depletion of fossil fuels and global warming are reasons which, according to scientists, make human beings leave the earth within six centuries so governments should take some serious actions and disburse an inordinate amount of money in order to avoid an environmental catastrophe on a global scale.
- Not only are we morally responsible for next generations on the earth, but also we should minimize the danger and threats that the environment may pose to our health. Statistics have revealed that in cities where the carbon footprint is more apparent, people suffer from lung diseases in a significantly higher rate.
